

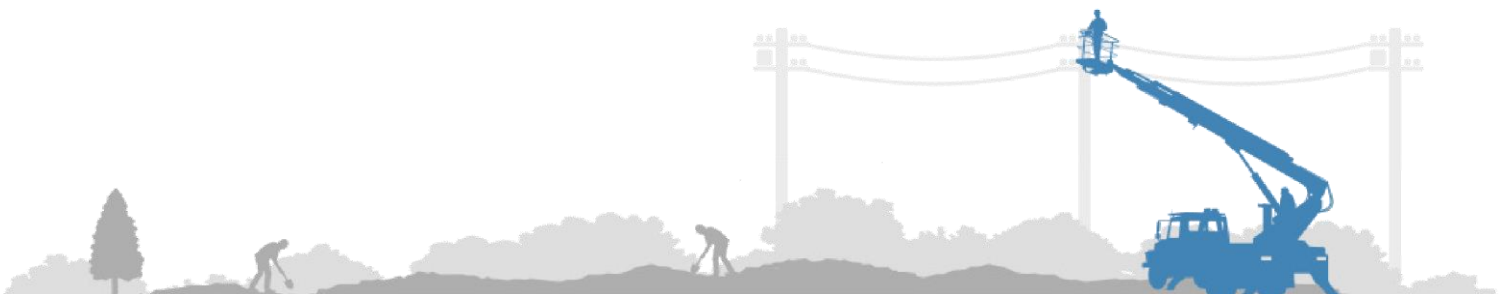

Emissions Reduction Alberta Grant

Energy Savings for Business helps Alberta businesses improve their efficiency and reduce emissions by supplying funding for commercial cost- and energy-saving technologies. Emissions Reduction Alberta offers small and medium-sized firms (industrial or commercial) up to \$250,000 per project, with a maximum of \$500,000 per company. There is broad flexibility with how this money can be spent. Individual businesses, non-profit organizations, co-operatives, farms registered as a business, and private schools not eligible for government funding are among some of the eligible applicants for this cash incentive.

The Canada Greener Homes Initiative

The Canada Greener Homes Initiative provides grants and a loan for EnerGuide evaluations and for retrofits.

Greener Home Grant

Grants from \$125 to \$5,000 to get back a portion of your costs for eligible home retrofits.

Up to \$600 as a maximum contribution toward the total costs of your pre and post retrofit EnerGuide evaluations.

The evaluations will recommend which of our eligible retrofits are the best options to improve the energy efficiency of your home. You will receive a grant only if you go all the way through the process – meaning that you complete both the evaluations and at least one recommended retrofit.

Greener Home Loan

The Canada Greener Homes Loan helps Canadians make their homes more energy-efficient and comfortable. It offers interest-free financing in addition to the Canada Greener Homes Grant to help you complete some of the more major retrofits recommended by your energy advisor.

Loan details:

- Maximum: \$40,000
- Minimum: \$5,000
- Repayment term: 10 years, interest-free
- Loan type: Unsecured personal loan on approved credit
